



Eastern Colorado Health Care System, Denver VAMC is excited to offer a Postdoctoral Fellowship in *Recovery and Couple & Family Psychology* beginning September 2016

The Eastern Colorado Health Care System is pleased to announce recruitment for a VA-funded **Postdoctoral Fellowship in Recovery and Couples/Family Therapy Services** for one clinical/counseling psychologist to begin on or around September 1, 2016. The goal of the postdoctoral Fellowship is to train a psychologist who has the breadth of knowledge and specific skills to provide evidence-based recovery-oriented services with individuals, couples and families. Fellows must demonstrate interest in pursuing VA careers with couple/family therapy and recovery-oriented practices as a significant focus. Fellows will spend at least 80% of their time clinically, providing couple and family therapy and recovery-oriented services within the ECHCS Mental Health Service Family Program and Life Skills Center, a Psychosocial Rehabilitation and Recovery Center (PRRC). The remaining 20% of fellow effort shall be allocated to a clinically relevant project which can include program development, program evaluation or an educational project related to the delivery of family or recovery-oriented services. Fellows will also participate in experiences in administration and clinical supervision to prepare for successful careers in the VA medical system.

Eligibility:

Applicants for postdoctoral fellowships must have attended APA-accredited doctoral programs in Clinical or Counseling Psychology and must have completed APA-accredited internships. All requirements for the doctoral degree must be completed prior to the start of the fellowship year. Persons with a PhD in another area of psychology who meet the APA criteria for re-specialization training in Clinical or Counseling Psychology are also eligible. Applicants must be U.S. citizens. As an equal opportunity training program, the fellowship welcomes and strongly encourages applications from all qualified candidates, regardless of gender, racial, ethnic, sexual orientation, disability or other minority status.

The following materials must be submitted in one packet:

1. Cover letter expressing interests, career goals and goodness of fit with fellowship. Please note fellowship(s) for which you are seeking consideration.
2. Curriculum Vita
3. A signed letter of status of completion or expected completion from APA-accredited internship.
4. Letter from your dissertation chair regarding your anticipated defense date *-if not already completed.*
5. Three signed letters of recommendation, one of which must be from an internship supervisor.
6. A work sample. This could be a case formulation, integrated assessment report, or program evaluation product. Please de-identify.
